Preliminary Review of Project subject to Warner Center 2035 21221 Oxnard Street, Woodland Hills, CA 91367

PLUM Chair August Steurer made a motion for the Board to approve: Associated Estates is proposing a mixed-use phased development of 379 residential dwelling units, including 82 work-live units, and approximately 71,000 square feet of office uses (with ground floor retail) in the College District area of the new Warner Center 2035 Plan. The total project floor area would be approximately 541,292 square feet. The residential portion of the project includes five stories above a three level parking structure (including one subterranean level), a five story on-grade portion, as well as a six story on-grade portion surrounding two sides of the parking structure, with heights ranging from 63' to 80'. The office portion of the project would be nine stories and approximately 150' tall. The project includes ¾ acre of Publicly Accessible Open Space. There will be 680 parking stalls provided after the completion of Phase 2. The project requires a Project Permit Compliance Review approval under the Warner Center 2035 Plan.
